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


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

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 91 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 91 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as ⁹¹ responses




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.












12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.















