SPECIAL CAMPING PROGRAMME **(13.03.2019 - 19.03.2019)**

Programme Description

The N.S.S Unit-I and NSS Unit-II of the College organized a SPECIAL CAMPING PROGRAMME from 13.03.2019 to 19.03.2019 at At 165 & 188 Ashok Avenue (Slum Areas) N.S.C Bose Road, Kolkata-700040 and 16 Khanpur Road, Kolkata-700040 in order to give the students an opportunity to build up the qualities of leadership, decision making and team spirit. It also developed a sense of responsibility in the students (N.S.S Volunteers) towards the society, particularly the poor people. The programme started with an opening song by our N.S.S volunteers. The Principal of college Dr. Tapan Kumar Ghosh inaugurated the programme. In his speech he not only advised our N.S.S volunteers to enjoy every moment of special camp but also to learn each and every aspect and utility of the special camp. He further demonstrated elaborately the main objectives of the special camp.

After the inauguration programme, the N.S.S volunteers were divided into ten groups (each groups had five students) for each NSS Units. They surveyed the socio-economic status slum people at residing at 165 & 188 Ashok Avenue's, N.S.C Bose Road, and Kolkata-700040 and 16 Khanpur Road, Kolkata-700040

In day two (14.03.2019) our N.S.S volunteers conducted an awareness camp on mosquito borne diseases in slum area in order to make them aware about these diseases so that they can take appropriate preventive measures. This was followed by Free Health check-up by Dr. Mira Roy (Gynecologist) for Women residing at above mentioned slum areas.

In day three (15.03.2019) an awareness programme on child health was organized. This was followed by free health check-up of slum people done by Dr. P.K. Roy (General Physician). Free medicines prescribed by Dr. P.K. Roy were distributed among slum people. In the post lunch session, our N.S.S Volunteers were busy to train the slum children for different cultural programme like Recitation, Quiz etc.

In day four (16.03.2019) a Blood Group determination was organised in association with Department of Zoology of the College. This was followed by an awareness programme on Self-employment for Women and avoiding early marriage for both Boys and Girls.

In day five (17.03.2019) awareness on Nutritional status of various foods and their role in maintenance of proper health of Slum area people was organised

in association with Department of Food and Nutrition of the College. This was followed by Sit & Drawing Competition for slum children.

In day six (18.03.2019) N.S.S volunteers conducted an awareness camp on common water borne diseases in slum area in order to make them aware about these diseases so that they can take appropriate preventive measures. This was followed by Quiz & Recitation competition for slum children.

In the closing day (19.03.2019), a pleasant cultural programme was organized by the slum children with the help of our N.S.S volunteers. Our N.S.S volunteers read out their findings in the socio-economic survey at the slum. This was followed by distribution of prizes to slum children for painting competition. Consolation prizes were distributed to all the participated children. Our principal, Dr. Tapan Kumar Ghosh distributed the certificate to all the N.S.S volunteers.

Thalassemia Awareness and Screening Camp programme

Thalassemia is an inherited haemoglobin disorder and is considered as life-threatening. Understanding local socio-cultural context and level of proper awareness about thalassemia is crucial for selecting effective prevention strategies. One of the prevention methods of thalassemia is carrier detection. Large scale awareness campaigns are being organized in India both by government and non-government organizations in favour of voluntary premarital screening to detect carriers of thalassemia and marriage between both carriers are strongly discouraged. The objective of the Thalassemia Awareness and Screening Camp programme was premarital screening for thalassemia for all students and staffs of the College so that carriers of thalassemia (if any) can be detected at the earliest and the disease can be prevented in future.

The Thalassemia Awareness and Screening Camp programme was organised by NSS Unit I and Unit II in collaboration THALASSAEMIA CONTROL UNIT CALCUTTA SCHOOL OF TROPICAL MEDICINE, KOLKATA on 07/09/2018 for the benefit of Students, Teachers and Non-Teaching staff of the College. It is noteworthy to mention here that the practice of organising Thalassemia Awareness and Screening Camp programme is being done by the College since 2017 onwards. This year (2018-2019) Thalassemia screening is done for a total of 170 people involving Students, Teachers and Non-Teaching staff of the College.

All 170 people who were screened for thalassemia was provided reports of their thalassemia screening conducted by HPLC from THALASSAEMIA CONTROL UNIT CALCUTTA SCHOOL OF TROPICAL MEDICINE, KOLKATA. Apart from that those who were detected carriers were given proper and useful counselling regarding prevention of thalassemia in near future.

HIV

DEFINITION

The human immune system reacts to HIV as a foreign invader that causes HIV infection and weakens acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS).

SYMPTOMS

During the acute stage, about 2-4 weeks of infection, many people experience symptoms such as fever, fatigue, swollen lymph nodes, and sore throat. In the chronic stage, there are few long-term symptoms. AIDS is diagnosed when CD4 counts fall below 200 cells/mm³.

PREVENTION

- HIV testing: ELISA is a process which helps in the detection of the presence of HIV antibody in the blood serum.
- Prevention of Blood Borne Transmission:
 - The presence of HIV antibody in the blood of blood banks should be tested before use.
 - In the same way, blood should not be used to collect blood from more than one person.
- Prevention of Transmission through Sexual Connections: Avoid unprotected sexual contacts.
- Risk Reduction: The safest method to reduce sexual transmission of HIV is to use condoms.
- HIV medications to prevent transmission: The first medicine to reverse AIDS is Zidovudine (ZDV or AZT).
- Zidovudine has been effective in the following cases:
 - Zidovudine (ZDV), Didanosine (DDI), Zalcitabine (ddC), Stavudine (d4T) and Abacavir.
 - Other medicines are Didanosine - Epivir (ddI) and Didanosine - Epivir (ddI).

CAUSES

- HIV is a sexually transmitted infection.
- It is caused by contact with or transfer of blood, pre-ejaculate, semen and vaginal fluids.
- After sexual transmission, the virus enters an infected partner's body.
- HIV infects cells with CD4 receptors and T-helper cells, such as T-helper cells (especially T4 cells), macrophages and dendritic cells.
- When CD4+ (white blood cells) cell numbers decline below a certain level, the weakened immunity to the body becomes progressively more susceptible to opportunistic infections.



Sir/Madam,

As we are all well aware about Thalassaemia disease that it is a genetic hereditary disease. Thalassaemia can not be cured. Cost of treatment of a Thalassaemia patient is approximately one lakh per year. It can be prevented by avoiding marriage between two Thalassaemia carriers. A carrier is not a diseased person and carrier states can not be detected with a special test called HPLC. If we screen hundred apparently healthy persons from a population, around 10% may be found to be carrier. The Government of West Bengal started a carrier detection program for control of Thalassaemia Syndrome in this state. The target groups is school/college students. As part of the program, we want to start an awareness and screening program among the students of your school. It may save their life long agony of giving birth of a Thalassaemia child.

We shall be grateful if you kindly give necessary permission in this regard and help to prevent Thalassaemia.

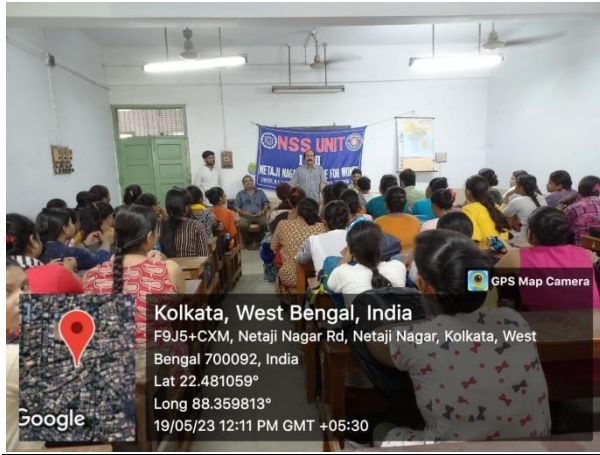


Aim of the Programme
