## Annual Report on e-Governance for the year 2021-22 Date:

#### Introduction:

E - Governance has been implemented in several essential operations of the college, such as administration, finance and accounts, student admission and support, library and examinations. Adequate infrastructural support necessary for this has been ensured in the institution, with computers, uninterrupted wi-fi connection and website support.

The details of the areas where e-governance has been effective are outlined below:

#### E -Governance in Administration:

- The Academic calendars, time tables, courses of study and their POs and COs, notices and important information about examinations and all ongoing college activities have been made available to the students through the college website.
- E-tendering and online processing of paperwork have been employed for purchase and infrastructural augmentation of the college from RUSA Grants, whenever so required.
- Classes have been held online for more than half part of the year following special time tables.
- Study materials, instructions for practicals and tutorials and e-books have been provide to the students over Whatsapp, e-mail and Google Classroom during this period.
- All policy meetings of the various cells and subcommittees have been conducted online for the regular functioning of the institution.
- Several webinars, cultural events and competitions have been held online almost throughout the year.
- Students have been regularly counselled online during the Pandemic period, to keep them from being demoralised and depressed.

#### E - Governance in Finance and Accounts:

- Staff salary has been processed through government IFMS and HRMS portals, and credited directly to their bank accounts.
- Purchase and utilisation of grants received from RUSA have been processed using e-tendering and PFMS.

 Admission of students to the first semester has been completely online with the help of the admission portal in college website, dedicated messaging service (SMS) and designated banks for financial transactions.
