

Swami Vivekananda Merit cum Means Scholarship (SVMCM)

The Government of West Bengal introduced this scholarship scheme to assist meritorious students belonging to economically backward families in West Bengal. This scheme aims to provide scholarships at different levels of higher studies at educational institutions. The SVMCM has been recently modified to incorporate a greater number of students.

The eligibility criteria of this scholarship (Fresh candidates) scheme are based mainly on –

- a) qualifying marks (for regular mode students of Class XI and XII, at under Graduate level in Science/Arts/Commerce, Engineering, Medical, and Technical / Professional courses, post Graduate-level students pursuing Science/Arts/Commerce & Technical/Management) and
- b) an upper ceiling for family income fixed at Rs 2,50,000/- per annum.

The eligibility criteria of this scholarship (Renewal candidates) scheme is mainly based on good academic performance in both semesters for renewal each year.

The total number of students from Netaji Nagar College for Women who benefitted from SVMCM in the last two years (both in B.A, B.Sc.-Fresh, and Renewal categories) are given as follows:

2021-2022: 83

2022-2023: 116

The current rate of scholarship amount provided to the UG students per year is given below:

B.A. students: Rs 12,000/- and

B.Sc. students: Rs 18,000/.
