

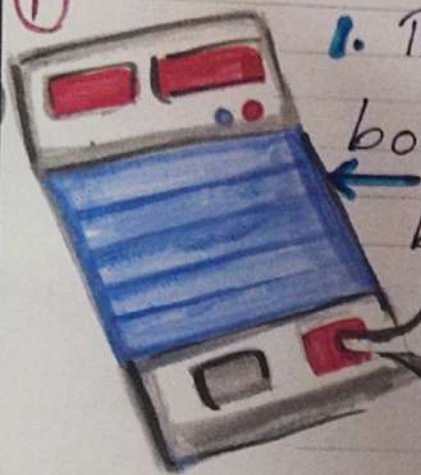

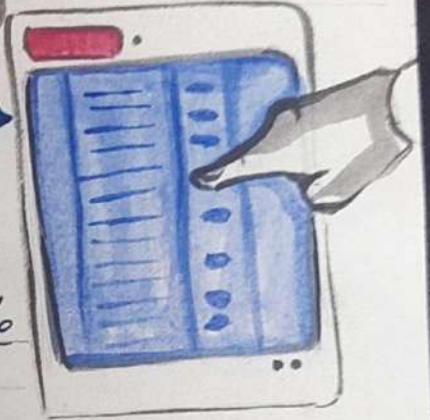
HOW DO WE VOTE?

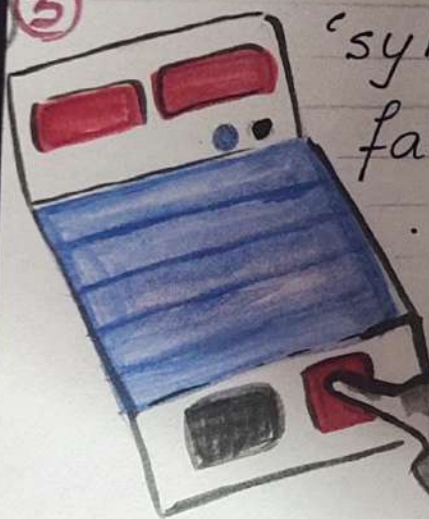


1. The officials at the poll booth press the blue 'Ballot' button to allow the voters to cast one vote.

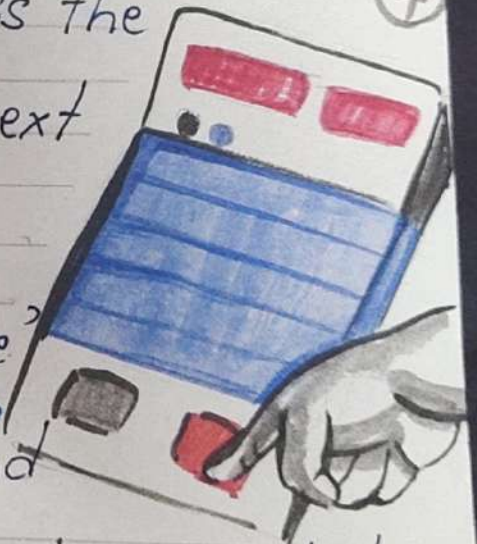


'symbol' of their favoured candidate

Legality Regarding Behaviour and Etiquette at the Polls.

Per MCL 168.744, MCL 168.931 and MCL 168.932 on election day within 100 feet of an entrance to a (polling) building it is AGAINST THE LAW...

- to approach voters to encourage voting for/against anything
- to post, distribute any material that directly or indirectly makes reference to an election, a candidate or a ballot question.
- to wear clothing, accessories, masks, electera that refer to a specific candidate, campaign or proposal
- to display "pro/con" or "vote for/against" material
- to offer money, assets, favour, job security, continued worship, affiliation or even safety from physical harm for voting in a prescribed manner.
- to deter a voter from voting.
- to intimidate voter through brandishing or aggressive show of force through firearm.

In addition to the above laws "selfies" are not allowed in the polls because you may inadvertently capture other voters and possibly the ballots in the background.

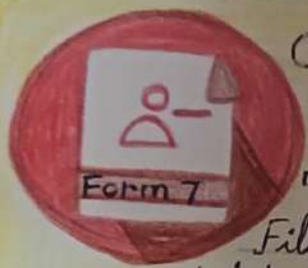
