Competition Guidelines

General Rules

1. A candidate is allowed to participate in only ONE category — either Oral Presentation or Poster Presentation. Participation in both categories is not permitted. Registration must be completed through the provided Google Form link.

Oral Presentation

2. The presentation may be delivered in English or Bengali., 3. Presentations must be prepared using PowerPoint (PPT)., 4. Time limit: 8 minutes for presentation followed by 2 minutes for Question & Answer session., 5. The first slide must clearly mention: • Title of the Presentation, Name of the Participant and Class

Poster Presentation

6. The poster must strictly adhere to the prescribed theme., 7. The size of the poster must be 2 ft × 3 ft (one art paper) for all participants., 8. Participation in the poster competition will be individual., 9. The Poster Title, Name and Class of the Participant must be clearly written at the top of the poster.

Quiz Competition

10. The quiz competition is open to all students., 11. It will be conducted as a group competition consisting of 2 members per group., 12. Registration must be completed through the provided Google Form link (one submission per group)., 13. A maximum of 5 groups will be allowed to participate (first-come, first-served basis).
